New Zealand – Pacific Islands COVID19 Service Update

Dear Valued Customers,

Swire Shipping's wishes to advise to changes on its New Zealand to Pacific Islands service. From May onwards, one vessel will be removed from the service and the frequency reduced from every 9 days to fortnightly.

These changes have become necessary as a result of lower cargo demand and the economic impact of COVID-19
